 - Identify opportunities for JLV to advance JFGP's communal goals.
- Develop and implement evaluative measures to ensure that:
 - All programs are strong and well-delivered; and
 - o All programs are meeting defined outcomes.
- Develop relevant educational materials and provide tools and resources to individuals and families to help them engage Jewishly and build meaningful Jewish lives.
- Consult and provide tools and resources to congregational and Jewish institutional leadership to help them create and deliver compelling Jewish engagement and learning experiences.
